

## Great Georgia Photo SWAP Contest Rules

- Submissions should be emailed to [swap@gaconservancy.org](mailto:swap@gaconservancy.org) and include the date and location of the photograph and name, email address and phone number for the photographer.
- Email submissions must not exceed 5MB in size.
- All submissions must be original, unaltered photographs and credited to the original photographer.
- The Georgia Conservancy and the Department of Natural Resources reserves the right to use any photographs submitted for the promotion of the Great Georgia Photo SWAP and the State Wildlife Action Plan (SWAP). Photographers may be posted on SWAP-related Web pages, used in printed and electronic materials and in other promotions.
- All other ownership rights of the photographs are retained by the photographer. Credit information will be included in all usage by the Georgia Conservancy and the Department of Natural Resources.
- The Great Georgia Photo SWAP features 26 high-priority species, with two species highlighted each month. Photographs of any of the species can be submitted at any time during the contest.
- The contest will continue from May 4, 2009 through May 31, 2010.
- The best photo for each species will be judged by the Georgia Conservancy and the Department of Natural Resources. The winner of the best photo for each of the 26 species will receive a one-year membership to the Georgia Conservancy and a state parks pass.
- In June 2010, a grand prize winner will be selected based on the number of submissions. The photographer who submits the most photographs during the contest year will receive a grand prize of a new digital camera.
